


Moving MiddleWiki Pages:

Note: You do not have to complete all three parts, be sure to note on Current Events what you are or are not doing. Best practice is to have someone else verify the pages are correct.

Part 1 – Exporting pages

1. Log in to middlewiki.midrealm.org (the legacy site)
2. Go to “Current Events” and put your name on the section of pages you are going to move.
3. Go to Special Pages > All Pages and click on the group of pages you selected in step 2. For this example, I chose the first section “(incipient) Ayerton to Armond le Chapentier”



4. Copy the page names, one page per line (I recommend copying them to notepad) Do not put two pages next to each other! On the screen you will have 3 columns of pages, you want 1 column.

5. Go back to Special Pages and find “Export Pages” at the bottom.



6. Paste the list of page titles into the box. Make sure you have one page title per line. “Include only the current revision, not the full history” should be checked and “save as a file” Do not include templates, we’ve already moved those. Click “Export” An xml file will be downloaded to your computer in whatever your default download location is (usually the “Downloads” folder.)

Export pages

You can export the text and editing history of a particular page or set of pages wrapped in some XML. This can be imported into another wiki using MediaWiki via the [import page](#).

To export pages, enter the titles in the text box below, one title per line, and select whether you want the current revision as well as all old revisions, with the page history lines, or the current revision with the info about the last edit.

In the latter case you can also use a link, for example [Special:Export/Main Page](#) for the page "Main Page".




Part 2 – Importing the pages

1. Log on to middlewiki.org (the new middlewiki site) and navigate to Special Pages and “Import

2. On the import pages screen, click upload and select the xml file you downloaded in the first pat. Set the interwiki prefix as “mk”





Part 3 – Verifying and locking pages

1. It helps to have two screens for this bit, have that import pages window open on one and the old wiki list of pages on the other. Click on your first page on both sites, compare them (it is normal for a lot of the links to be red on the new site as those pages may not have been moved yet, don’t worry about that.)
2. Click “History” on the legacy site page and make sure it has not been updated since you imported it.
3. Click on the “Protect” tab

4. Set the page to “Administrators only” and in the comments section put “page moved to new site”
